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Anticoaqulation Clinic

The concept:

As integrated systems expand to offer more intensive ambulatory care services and cover broader geographic areas, an Outpatient Anticoagulation Clinic is likely to become more prominent, improving patients' access to, and continuity of care, implementing disease management and focusing on quality-related outcomes, which help contribute to lowering the total cost of patient care.

Objectives:

The goal of this service is to offer a standardized process for the individualized assessment, adjustment, monitoring and education of patients receiving warfarin and other anticoagulants on an outpatient basis by a multidisciplinary team in which the clinical pharmacist plays an integral role.
