You will need someone to drive you home on the day of the procedure. You will also require four OPD post-operative visits.

Approx Total cost:

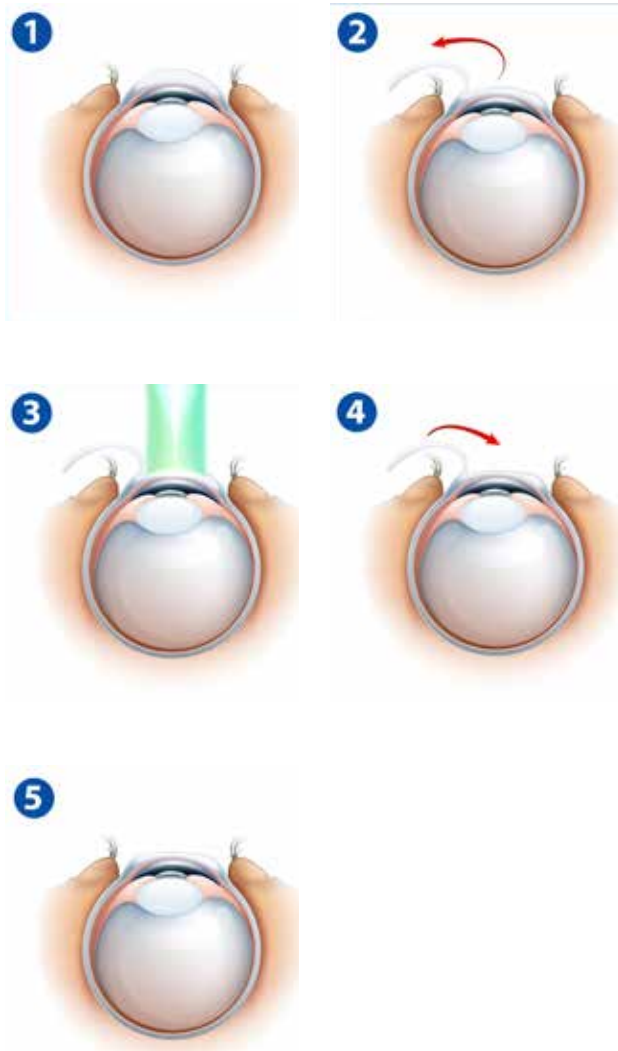

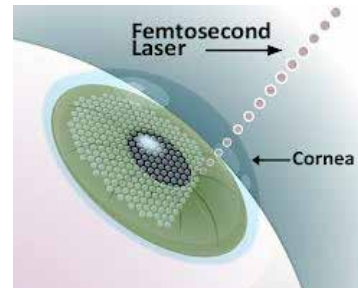

Best Candidates

- Mild or moderate myopia
- Hyperopia
- Astigmatism
- Adequate corneal thickness
- 21 to 45 years of age
- Non-diabetic but stable diabetic patients can be considered
- Five years of stable eyesight



In addition to putting patients at greater ease the advantages of bladeless femtosecond laser include:

- More predictable corneal flap thickness
- Decreased risk of corneal abrasions
- Decreased risk of induced astigmatism

Procedure Time:

About 10 minutes per eye.

Hospital Stay:

The procedure is day surgery and you will need someone to drive you home at the end.

Typical results:

20/20 vision without glasses or contact lenses

Recovery time:

Only one week off work and a few weeks to achieve complete visual recovery.
